ORDINANCE NO. 1014

AN ORDINANCE SETTING PAY OF OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF FARMER CITY, DEWITT COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, municipalities are entitled to determine its own rules of proceeding pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/3.1-40-5 and to set the pay of officials pursuant to 50 ILCS 145/2, which may not be changed within a term of office or within 180 days of the beginning of a term of office;

WHEREAS, currently, Council Members are paid \$50.00 per official meeting of the City Council attended. The Mayor is paid a flat \$200.00 per month. The Treasurer is paid \$750.00 per year. That the City officials believe the rate of pay for certain officials is too low and that a rate of pay of \$75.00 per official meeting of the City Council attended for each Council Member; and a flat \$225.00 per month for the Mayor is appropriate, reasonable and fair.

Whereas, officials are sworn in on the first Monday in May after the election, which will be May 6, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMER CITY, DEWITT COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Upon expiration of 180 days after the effective date of this Ordinance, the Council members of the City of Farmer City, Illinois shall be paid the sum of \$75.00 per official meeting attended; and the Mayor shall be paid a flat \$225.00 per month. The Treasurer's pay shall remain at \$750.00 per year. This shall apply to each official upon the beginning of a new term of office.

<u>Section 2.</u> This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

Last year, after multiple searches (6+) we determined that we had not budgeted enough money. So, we raised the amount from \$20,000 to \$40,000 and have found a good used one for \$35,077.

This is a used truck from the City of Washington. Its in good condition, mechanically, but had some rust and wear on the bed. The seller, Rush Truck Center, agreed to repaint and repair those areas for free.

This is well under the state bid price so I recommend approval of the purchase for \$35,077 from Rush Truck Center in Champaign.

ORDINANCE NO. 1016

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THROUGH COMMERCIAL VEHICLE TRAFFIC ON PARTS OF JOHN STREET AND RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, Section 75.10, entitled "Scope and Effect of Size, Weight, and Load Regulations", of Chapter 75 of the Farmer City Code, as supplemented and amended, (the "Farmer City Code") and Section 11-208 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208), as supplemented and amended (the "IVC"), provide that the Mayor and the City Council (the "Corporate Authorities") of the City of Farmer City, DeWitt County, Illinois (the "City") may designate by ordinance or resolution commercial vehicle restrictions on any highway under the jurisdiction of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities desire to prohibit through commercial vehicle traffic on parts of John Street for the purpose of safety of the public and to prevent damage to said streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMER CITY, DEWITT COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Prohibition on Through Commercial Vehicle Traffic</u>. That through commercial vehicle traffic (in either direction) is prohibited on the following streets and are so designated pursuant to the above-cited provisions of the Farmer City Code and the IVC:

Street so Designated:

John Street starting at the intersection of Rt. 54/Clinton Avenue and John on the south to the intersection of Jackson Street and John on the north

- Section 2. Erection of Signs. That the City Manager shall cause appropriate signs to be erected along each such street as specified in Section 1 of this Ordinance as soon as reasonably practicable. The prohibition on through commercial vehicle traffic along the street(s) so designated by this Ordinance shall become effective when such applicable signs are so erected.
- <u>Section 3</u>. <u>Superseder</u>. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances designating traffic control regulations in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby superseded.
- Section 4. Penalty. That all through commercial vehicles and persons violating this Ordinance shall be guilty of an ordinance violation and subject to a minimum fine of \$250 and maximum fine of \$500, as allowed by law and ordinance.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish (by pamphlet) this ordinance immediately after its passage. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this ordinance shall become effective immediately after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
