RESOLUTION 2018-24

RESOLUTION APPROVING ENGINEERING AGREEMENT WITH BHMG FOR DESIGN OF UTILITY EXTENSION NORTH OF 1-74

WHEREAS, the City of Farmer City desires to extend utilities north of Interstate 74 for purposes of possible new development;

WHEREAS, state law and local ordinances require the City to enter into professional engineering agreements on the basis of demonstrated competence and qualifications and not on the basis of lowest bid; and

WHEREAS, the City needs to design said utility extension and the City desires to hire the engineering firm of BHMG, which has demonstrated competence and qualifications to design said utility extension, at a cost not to exceed the sum of \$31,000;

WHEREAS, the City believes it to be in the communities' best interest to enter into a professional engineering services agreement with BHMG not to exceed the sum of \$31,000 for the purpose of design of utility extension north of Interstate 74;

THEREFORE, the City Council hereby directs the City Manager to execute a professional engineering services agreement with BHMG to design the utility extension north of Interstate 74 at a cost not to exceed the sum of \$31,000.
