 Grants are available for revitalizing, acquiring and demolishing vacant properties; however, they require cities to have a vacant property registry in place to apply. Many communities have registries which require owners to register the property with the city, pay a fee and set a timeline for turnover. Waivers can be provided for special circumstances. City manager McLaughlin is asking council if they would like to move forward with establishing a vacant property registry and what they would like it to look like. The council said they're interested but would like some more time to review the draft ordinance.
- F. Approve soliciting bids for N John St drainage improvements and Weedman Park parking lot repaying.

This work will resolve drainage issues at the entrance of the pool. It is a flat area that is not connected to storm drains. The purpose of this work is to "slow the flow" during drainage. It will also include paving the Weedman Park parking lot and add ADA parking in front of the pool house. Funds for the project will be a \$75,000 state grant and TIF monies. The city is hoping for an early spring completion.

MOTION by McKinley to approve the solicitation of bids for N John St drainage improvements and Weedman Park parking lot repaving. Seconded by Friedrich. Voted unanimously. Motion carried.






