Upon discovering the orphaned UST during roadway grading activities construction was suspended in the area as removal activities will be required in order to resume the roadway grading activities. There were no obvious signs of impact around the surface of the orphaned UST; however, there was a prevalent leaded gasoline odor coming from within the orphaned UST which was determined to contain approximately 800 gallons of residual product/water and approximately 6-8" of sludge/aggregate material. Ambient PID readings around the compromised fill tube ranged between 484-595 ppm.

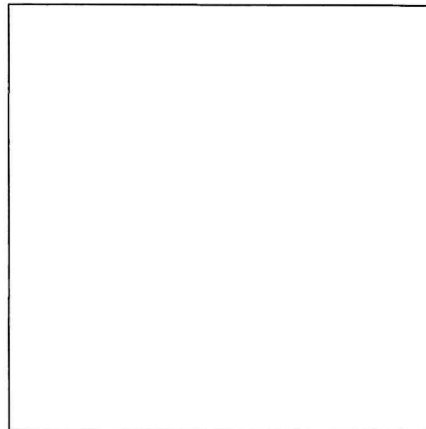

Duties of Personnel Implementing Regulated Substances Construction Monitoring:

- * Accurately read, understand, and implement engineering contract plans, regulated substances special provision and BDE 2730/2730A.
- * Field screening for potential contaminants associated with regulated substances in real-time using field instrumentation. Typically, PID/FID is used but other instruments may be required based on the nature of regulated substances present or suspected.
- * Accurately document the management of materials with regards to the project requirements. This includes accurately marking areas of regulated substance, and confirming that the materials excavated are manifested and sent to their proper disposal facilities (CCDD, non-special waste landfill, etc.) Notify the Resident Engineer (RE) of any deviations from the BDE/D1 Special Provision immediately.

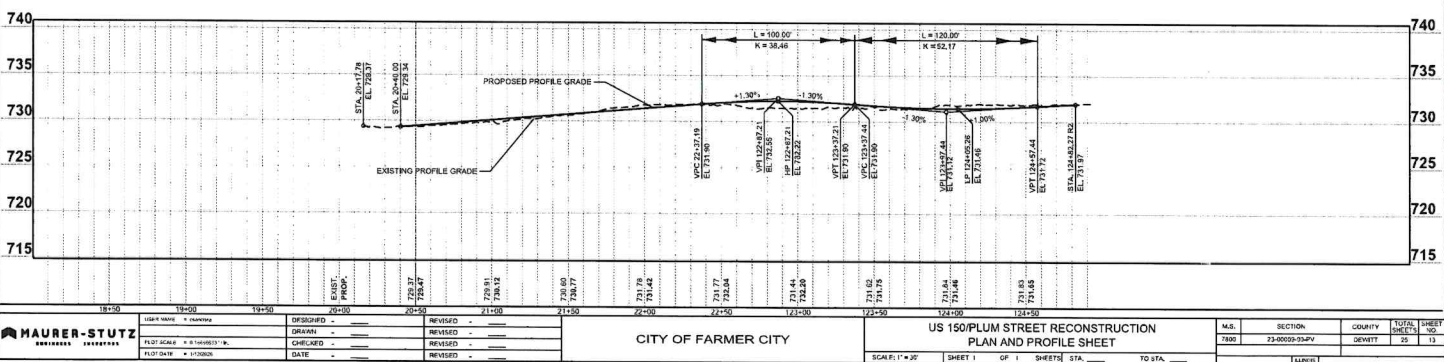

I was just informed that an orphaned UST(s) were just encountered/compromised at approximate STA 124+00, 15' RT on the Farmer City project. The plan sheet depicting the approximate location is attached for reference. Based on the preliminary pictures it also appears that a former hydraulic lift was encountered indicating the presence of an additional hydraulic oil UST as well. According to additional information received this was the site of a former service/gas station.

I will be mobilizing to the Site in the morning for measurement purposes, additional photos, and to develop the anticipated costs for the removal activities.
